Stepping Up To College-And-Career Readiness

VCP Middle School supports whole child development with academic and social-emotional learning so students can be better prepared to step into high school and take full advantage of college-and-career readiness (CCR) initiatives.

These programs include daily advisory coursework, semi-annual VCP Exhibitions, and advancement placement classes that offer high school credit.



DAILY ADVISORY COURSES

Students explore career pathways, engage with social-emotional learning, and practice interpersonal skills for one class period every day.



VCP EXHIBITIONS

Starting in Grade 7, students present publicly each semester to volunteer panelists to build professional skills.



AP COURSES

Advanced placement courses allow students to earn high school credit early.
